# **Checklist**

# **Settlement Permit**

The settlement permit is an unlimited residence permit and entitles the holder to pursue any gainful employment.

### Guidance on meeting the requirements (§ 9 (2) AufenthG):

- 1. You have been in possession of a valid residence permit for at least five years (previous periods of training and study are credited at half)
- 2. You have acquired entitlements to benefits for sufficient old-age provision: At least 60 months of compulsory or voluntary contributions to the statutory pension insurance or comparable benefits
- 3. You have sufficient knowledge of German (B 1)
- 4. You have basic knowledge of the legal and social order in Germany
- 5. You meet the requirements for the extension of your current residence permit

### The following deviating prerequisites apply (not conclusive):

- A. Family members of a German citizen (§ 28 (2) AufenthG):
  - after three years with sufficient knowledge of German (B 1)
  - the family partnership with spouse, child or parent with the German citizen in the federal territory continues to exist
- B. Spouses of a foreign professional with a settlement permit in accordance with § 18c AufenthG (§ 9 (3a) AufenthG):
  - after three years with sufficient knowledge of German (B 1)
  - gainful employment of at least 20 hours per week.

#### Required documentation for the application:

- National passport
- Sufficient pension provision
  - pension information or pension statement from the German Pension Insurance or
  - proof of entitlement to comparable benefits from another insurance or pension institution
- German language skills
  - language certificate from a certified language course provider (telc, Goethe Institut, ECL, ÖSD)
  - certificates from an integration course (if available)
- Knowledge of the legal and social order
  - Successful completion of the test "Living in Germany" or "Einbürgerungstest" (not applicable if you have attended a secondary school in Germany)
- Proof of continuous adequate health insurance coverage for all family members:
  - in case of a statutory health insurance: current insurance certificate
  - in case of private health insurance: confirmation of Annex 1 by the health insurance company\*.
- Rental contract stating the current rental costs and the size of the apartment





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- Proof of income:
  - certificate of earnings of the last three months of the family members living in one household
  - freelance work: current profit calculation by tax advisor: form Information on gross/net income\* and orders/contracts with several clients (if applicable)
- German university degree (if applicable)
- Current biometric photo (must only be presented at the appointment)\*\*

- \*\* You can have your photo taken at a booth on site for a fee of 6 euros.

Please allow 15 minutes prior to your appointment for this.

Additional documents may be requested. The application is subject to a fee. Payment only in cash or with EC card. Credit card payment is not possible.
