

# Checklist

## Job search

### The following documents are required for the application:

- Completed and signed application form\*
- National passport
- Proof of continuous sufficient health insurance coverage:
  - In the case of a statutory health insurance: current insurance confirmation
  - In the case of private health insurance: confirmation of Annex 6 or 7 by the health insurance company\*
- Proof of financial means (income, bank balances, other assets) or submission of a declaration of commitment
- Rental contract
- Recognised university degree ([www.anabin.kmk.org](http://www.anabin.kmk.org))
- Original certificate of professional or university education with apostille / legalization in case of foreign documents
- Proof of recognition of professional qualifications: Extract from "Anabin" at [www.anabin.kmk.org](http://www.anabin.kmk.org) for university degrees recognition certificate from the responsible office (see [www.anerkennung-in-deutschland.de](http://www.anerkennung-in-deutschland.de))
- If no university degree is held: Proof of sufficient German language skills (B1) based on a language certificate from a certified language course provider (telc, Goethe Institut, ÖSD)
- Current biometric photograph (no copies)\*\*

\*\* Not applicable at the Hamburg Welcome Center for Professionals and at the Immigration Service Offices in the districts of Hamburg-Mitte, Altona and Hamburg-Nord: You can have your photo taken at a booth on site for a fee of 6 euros.

Please plan enough time prior to your appointment for this.

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### Information for the application:

To apply for a residence permit, please contact the Immigration Office of the Hamburg District Offices responsible for your place of residence or the Hamburg Welcome Center for Professionals.

To determine the responsible district office, proceed as follows:

1. Call up the Hamburg Administration Guide (Behördenfinder):

2. In the "Suchbegriff" field, enter the term "Ausländerangelegenheiten" and select "Suchen"
3. Enter the registration address in Hamburg (street and house number)
4. Select the red button "Weiter"
